Chosen Charity Information - Revive

Basics

You've chosen to jump with JumpMAD to raise money for Revive! The following information should give you everything you need to know about YOUR charity, the required sponsor amounts, a bit to introduce myself as your JumpMAD representative for Revive and hopefully some encouragement to start fundraising.

The minimum sponsorship level to jump for Revive is £350. That means you need to raise at least £350, so that you don't have to pay for any of the dive yourself. If you don't raise this minimum amount you will have to make up the difference out of your own pocket. This is the only way we can guarantee that the charity will get an accepted level of funding in exchange for payment made towards your skydive.

By now you will probably have paid the £60 deposit to sign up, via the secure payment on our website. A further payment of £180 is required a minimum of 1 working week prior to the jump. After your big day, there is a 4 week grace period to collect the sponsor you've been pledged, please do your absolute best to collect all your sponsorship in accordance with our terms and conditions.

Contacting you!

If you've paid your deposit you should by now have received a confirmatory email with all the details which you have chosen. Likewise, once we've booked you in for your dive day with your chosen drop zone, we'll email you to confirm both the date and location. In the event that the drop-zone cannot receive you to jump on your preferred days we'll give you a call and see when else you may be available.

At the half-way stage between booking confirmation and the dive day, we will check that you are still committed to the jump and to be there to give you any help, advice or support in your fundraising (minimum of £350). There will be invoices sent soon for the remaining jump cost; while we'd prefer payment as early as possible you'll need to pay a minimum of 1 working week prior to the dive to allow funds to clear, paying early saves you the hassle of trying to find last minute finances closer to your dive!



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Fundraising for Revive!

Fundraising is the foundation of JumpMAD, however we have no control over how you fundraise. We want to see a difference made for Revive by the funds which you can raise by making this jump. We want to do everything we can to help you surprise yourself, family and friends but ultimately it comes down to your own enthusiasm and commitment;

- Tell everyone you know about it!
- Be persistent in getting sponsored
- Get family and friends to help you – give them plenty of sponsor forms
- Do some publicity stunts
- Set some fundraising times and targets and stick to them. Think big!
